A transfer of **\$1,500** from **COGS Unallocated** to **Music Theory Society Contractual Services Category**.




Our Music Theory Forum proudly features presentations from graduate students and faculty alike from all across North America. We also invite a senior scholar to deliver a keynote speech on any topic of their choosing. Our keynote speaker this year is Prof. Ellie Hisama, dean of the Faculty of Music at the University of Toronto and Professor Emerita of Music at Columbia University. She is also the founding director of “Forthe Daughters of Harlem: Working in Sound,” a multi-year workshop that pairs girls and young women of color from New York public schools with Columbia music faculty, graduates and other mentors to produce and record music.
