Sponsored by Speaker Adam O'Neill

Permission for Music Theory Society to utilize allocated COGS fund after the event.

WHEREAS: COGS allocated \$1,500.00 to FSU Music Theory Society for their annual Forum Conference keynote speaker honorarium for Dr. Stephen Rodgers (University of Oregon) at the beginning of the Fall 2018 semester;

WHEREAS: Dr. Rodgers engaged in travel for the conference on January 19, 2019 without a Nole Central request having been submitted by the conference co-chairs and/or the Society's Treasurer;

WHEREAS: Dr. Rogers was provided the incorrect reimbursement form on the date of the conference, rather than filing the honorarium request through Nole Central;

WHEREAS: the failure on behalf of the Society's conference co-chairs and/or treasurer to submit the Nole Central request was inadvertent and confused with another type of reimbursement procedure;

WHEREAS: the Society does not charge a conference registration/attendance fee in order to make attendance at or participation in the conference open to FSU graduate and undergraduate students, in addition to the general public;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that COGS grant this RSO permission to use the originally allocated funds to provide Dr. Rogers his keynote speaker honorarium;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the allocation of these funds relieves the Society of providing the honorarium with nonexistent funds among their relatively small member count; and


THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that copies of this resolution be sent to:
