**Purpose:** To add one new advocacy seat in order to better represent the LGBTQ+ graduate student population on Florida State University's campus.



**Purpose:** To provide additional funding for graduate and professional students to attending conferences during the month of October.





## **Chapter 111: Elections**

111.3 In addition, one seat shall be allocated for each of the following: Graduate Student Housing Advocate, International Student Advocate, LGBTQ+ Student Advocate, Minority Student Advocate, Student Veterans Advocate, Students with Disabilities Advocate, and At Large, all of which shall be open to any graduate student at FSU.
