# Resolution

## 28<sup>th</sup> Congress of Graduate Students

**Resolution #:** 11

**Sponsored by:** Deputy Speaker Blake-Hedges

**Date:** October 5th, 2020

**Whereas:** On September 21, 2020 the 28th Congress passed Resolution 9 to resolve that “the application to apply for conference presentation and attendance grants will open on October 1st, 2020 and close either after funding is depleted or on February 28th, 2021, whichever comes first”;

**Whereas:** there has not been notice of the application opening on the COGS Funding website nor to the travel representatives that need to process these requests;

**Whereas:** there should not be an unfair advantage to graduate students applying for a conference presentation and/or attendance grant that were aware of the opening before an official notice was posted on the COGS website;

**Whereas:** the travel representatives that process these applications should be fully aware of the opening of the application for the grants before we proceed with accepting applications;

**Be it resolved by the Twenty-seventh Congress of Graduate Students of Florida State University that:** the application to apply for conference presentation and attendance grants will open on October 14th, 2020 and close either after funding is depleted or on February 28th, 2021, whichever comes first.

**Be it further resolved that:** copies of this resolution be sent to the SGA accounting staff, the Interim Director of SGA, Dr. Brandon Bowden, and the Vice President of Student Affairs, Dr. Amy Hecht.
