



Professor Ewell will prepare a one-hour research presentation as well as lecture graduate-level music theory classes the Friday before the Forum. This event provides graduate students an opportunity to organize a scholarly conference that models other conferences in their field. It also provides undergraduate students an opportunity to experience music theory at the professional level.
