- Review of Summer
 - Chabot: The google drive has all the evidence we've collected so far as a Board. We've had 2 or 3 more submissions since we last met. Senator Gipalo was forwarded for a seat without warning. Jonathan Marcus applied twice to an Arts and Sciences seat. The second time he was called by someone not confirmed on exec, and was asked one question. We thought that didn't constitute an interview under statutes, so we advised him to take legal action. His other application, he was not contacted. Rawan Abhari was asked by VP Janvier to sing a song in her cabinet interview. We've heard from others that they were asked to do the same and felt compelled to. John Alvarez applied for a COSSPP seat over summer, never received an interview, applied again, and then seat 1- a different seat- opened up. When he contacted Exec, they interviewed him for seat 1 as "compensation". He was never given an interview for the seat he actually applied for. The one we've been focusing the most on is Marcus because he was contacted by a private student- Abhari before she was a secretary. We also think

that the singing allegations could constitute hazing. That's what's happened so far, are there any questions? I encourage everyone to go back and read the minutes and look at the evidence because we will probably not bring people in to interview a second time. I'm hoping we can collect the remaining testimony at our next meeting. Then, we will contact exec. I'm hoping to wrap all this up within a month.

- Leckie: I know you previously tried to get exec meeting minutes. Are we doing anything else to obtain them?
- Chabot: I'll email them again, but I was asked to give them time to look into it. I'll email again now that we've started school back up.
- Leckie: Good, we should be able to get access to those whenever we want.
- Chabot: Keep in mind that we have the Investigative Board, which deals specifically with the appointment process. In Judiciary, there is an outstanding subpoena for code of ethics violations.
