New Business:

- **Bill #57** - Sponsored by Chair Gonzalez - Representing the estimated amount in the budget to be submitted to the Student Senate President for Budget Committee Allocation in the fiscal year of 2022-2023.
 - **Opening:** Chair Gonzalez: This is a procedural aspect to submitting the annual budget. As you can see all of our lovely names are on there. Our budget has increased for the first time in a while from 13.9 million to 14.6 million so our jobs in allocating this year should be a little easier this time around.
