This bill would remove this line of text from the statute in order to cancel this requirement.

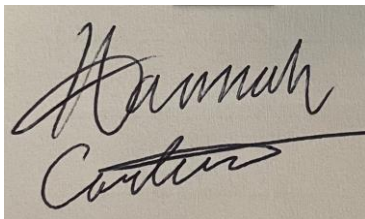
