- **Bill 33- Sponsored by Gerdts- Amending student body statutes chapter 711.4**

**New Business:**

- Resolution 23-
  - Daraldik opens
  - Yields with 2 minutes left for closing
  - Technical and non-debatable questions
  - Motion by Chabot to go into roundtable, seconded by MacMillan
  - Mougey asks if this is a check, Daraldik responds that it is to promote money being spent in the views of the Student Body
  - Want money invested in things promoted by the students and faculty
  - Is this not already happening, Daraldik responds that there is nothing that he knows about, but it is still good to promote
  - Selva asks about stocks and if it's talking about firms, Daraldik responds saying that he was not sure
  - Warren says that she was at the meeting he attended and says this resolution is a mirror from universities.
  - Gerdts says that Big 10 presidents signed these types of bills in their respective student governments
  - Daraldik says that this has to be amended
  - Chabot moves to amend 4<sup>th</sup> whereas as to amend "effects" to "Affects"
    - Seconded by warren, sponsor finds it friendly
  - MacMillan Moves to call the question, Chabot seconds
  - Closing by Daraldik
    - **Yes 6 (Chabot, Maymon, Ferguson, Mougey, Warren, MacMillan) Nay 0, Abs, 2 (Jacobsen and Selva)**
- Bill 33- Sponsored by Gerdts
  - Gerdts opening



- Stops with 3:27 seconds to closing
- No technical and non-debatable questions
- Motion to move into roundtable by Fink, seconded by MacMillan
- Gerdts doesn't think that the ability to re-nominate would weigh down the senate because this award is not used much
- Chabot says that she was surprised this wasn't the case before hand and applauds sponsor
- Committee is discussing different ways to try and word an amendment on ways that the award would be given without Senate President having to relinquish chair
- Gerdts cautions against making the chair the sponsor, Jacobsen also has this concern
- Why was this brought up asked by Fink
- Gerdts says that having it as a resolution makes it larger in a sense to have the senate award it
- Denton says that changing the wording you would have to explain the processes of president and pro temp in a different section
- MacMillan says that we could make it more uniform to get a forwarded letter but that can bring problems
- Gerdts says that we are using a one size fits all approach and think that there will conflict of interest in all options
- Jacobsen sees a possible conflict of interest
- MacMillan says doesn't happen enough for relinquishing to be a problem
- Chabot says she wants to see this in the senate after passed
- Gerdts says he won't withdraw and hopes committee to vote on it
- MacMillan asks president if relinquishing would be uncomfortable
- Denton says he is ok with going either way
- Jacobsen asks if tabling is ok
- Gerdts says he doesn't want to table
- Jacobsen asks if gerdts is open to talking about ways to change then amend
- Gerdts says there won't be multiple bills
- Chabot is confused on the president's roles
- MacMillan calls the question, Fink seconds
- Sponsor closes
  - **Yes 4 (Jacobsen, MacMillan, Maymon, Chabot) Nay 5 (Fink, Ferguson, Selva, Mougey, Daraldik) Abs 0**
