- **Bill 51 - Adamyk**
 - Adamyk opens stating that the bill aligns with a supreme court recommendation to remove the requirement that the presidents of the four greek councils attend the State of the Student Body address due to the fact that the greek councils operate under OFSL, not SGA so we cannot require that they attend SGA events
 - Yields 1:31 to closing
 - Primozic moves to go into roundtable, Macmillan seconds
 - Leckie asks whether we have the power to regulate student organizations
 - Adamyk answers that Greek life is not like other RSOs
 - Chabot clarifies that Greek organizations do not ask for funding or any help from SGA and thus we should not try to regulate them
 - Macmillan says that he supports the bill because it cleans up the powers of SGA and removes something that we do not have power over anyways
 - Leckie asks who gave the advisory opinion, Adamyk answers that he does not know
 - Chabot moves to call question, seconded by Macmillan
 - Adamyk closes
