  - Opening Statement:
    - **Quentin England:** Thank you for hearing me first, it currently very early in the morning here in England. I am here to receive your support for student Body chief of staff. I was funnily enough, ran for this position 3 years ago, knowing what I know now I am not surprised I did not receive that position. Having been IA chair I am familiar with all this. I know the rule and duties of the Student Body Chief of Staff due to my experience with the former chief and with my perspective in SGA. I know the goal of the chief is to support the Student Body president. I would like to assist President Gabadage in carrying out what he wants to achieve. I look forward to answering any of your questions.

    - **Rowan:** Are you financially certified?
    - **England:** I will recertify July first when it expires, yes.
  - General Questions:
    - **Annad:** I know it is quite late, what is an example how you can support our President and what experience do you have to this?
    - **England:** I can take all pressure off with confirmations and appointment, I believe he is looking to me to consult him but to take a lead on this. I have experience in senate and working with this admin and the last President.
    - **Clermont:** What are your goals?
    - **England:** Personal projects Is not the rule of chief, I believe I should be primary aid to the president, my job is to assist the Student Body President. Whatever that looks like: emails, meetings. I would love to work on internal affairs, and review our app process, there are points that can be fleshed out.

    - **England:** I am not picky, personally the structure works well. I think the advisor cabinet can be structured in a similar way that would work well.
    - **Fermin:** I love how you see this role as a support role it will take precise management, do you feel you are equipped with that?
    - **England:** Working international programs I am used to dealing with high stress especially during the Covid-19 pandemic, I am also a graduate student now through communications, I like to think I am experienced with dealing with these situations before.
