### **Land Acknowledgement read by Senator Anand**

    - **Opening Statement:**

Iaconis: I completed my degree in 3. I want to make sure that, reflecting on my experience, and how different my experience was from the typical student, I wasn't to use those differences to remind myself that everyone's experience is different.
