Messages from the Executive Branch:

- SGA President Levin: Discussed his veto and the reasoning behind it, with regards to updates to the Student Code of Conduct. He also spoke about the efforts of the Executive Branch and FSU's conversations regarding the state of the nation, including the statement Exec posted earlier this evening.
