Resolution 50                      Sponsored by Senators Hellman, Pedraja (P), Arellano, Kerley, Patel, White (Co)  
This resolution acknowledges the significance of the Fourth of July as a national holiday in the United States, commemorating the Declaration of Independence. It emphasizes the importance of unity, reflection on the sacrifices made by the country's forefathers, and the promotion of civic engagement and historical consciousness among the student body at Florida State University. The resolution encourages the celebration and recognition of Independence Day, participation in local events, educational activities, and discussions, and calls upon the university administration to support and promote these initiatives while urging the community to reflect on upholding principles of liberty, justice, and equality. **(Tabled on the floor 06.14. This eliminates the position of secretary from being a major office.

- Bill 56                      Sponsored by Senators Cofer, Humberg (P) Butrum, Gomez, Gorelick, Randall, Richards, Waller (Co)  
This bill would allow students enrolled in the Panama City campus the ability to vote for Student Body Treasurer, and also amends the Panama City statutes to modernize the language surrounding their voting procedures. **(Referred to Internal Affairs and Judiciary. Passed in Judiciary 04.20. Tabled in Internal Affairs 04.24. Passed in Internal Affairs 06.05. Tabled on the floor 06.14)**
- Bill 64                      Sponsored by S. White (P)  
This bill specifies that RSOs who are given A&S monies must have a Senate transfer bill padded if they want to transfer funds which originate from A&S fees between budget categories. **(Referred to Finance and Judiciary 05.26. Passed in Finance 06.06. Passed in Judiciary 06.07. Tabled on the floor 06.14)**
- Bill 65                      Sponsored by S. White (P) Pedraja, Hellman, Kerley (Co)  
To update the statues for the Student Body Treasurer to be able to have a greater opportunity to make a beneficial impact on the Student Body.
