WHEREAS: The Florida State University Office of Governmental Affairs

established a legislative agenda for the past legislative

session, and

WHEREAS: The agenda included several topics important to Florida

State University students, and

WHEREAS: The Office of Governmental Affairs was successful in

influencing policy for the student body's interest, and

WHEREAS: The Office of Governmental Affairs lobbied on behalf of the

student veteran constituency for in-state tuition for post-9/11 student veterans, a need-based scholarship program to cover gaps in the GI Bill, and funding for the Honorably Discharged Student Veterans Assistance Program (HDSVAP),

and

WHEREAS: All of the aforementioned issues were passed unanimously in

both chambers and signed into law by Governor Scott over

the summer, and

WHEREAS: There is a significant student constituency of children of

undocumented immigrants, as well as undocumented

immigrants, on FSU's campus, and

WHEREAS: The Office of Governmental Affairs advocated for In-State

Tuition for Children of Undocumented Persons which was also

signed into law by Governor Scott this summer, and

WHEREAS: Several Senators and Representatives were influential in

passing these items on the legislative agenda, and

WHEREAS: The 66th Student Senate would like to recognize the work

done by these individuals, therefore
