- **Notes of the Event/Item:**

- Opening:
 - The Big Event is a largest, one-day, student run service project in Tallahassee. The Big Event brings together hundreds of FSU,

Florida A&M, and TCC students to help the Tallahassee community. They help create a campus culture of unity and service. On 2/11/23 at 8am, students will meet at IM fields. They will then choose their own service site. Guest speakers from all three colleges will speak at the event kickoff. At 10am all students will go to the different service sites to complete their community service. At 3pm, after the service is done, all students will return to drop off their supplies and head home.

- The Big Event is asking for money to provide food and t-shirts for the 500 students at the event. The prefer catering from Panera and t-shirts from 4 Imprint.
- Questions:
 - President Diaz: Since quotes for t-shirts are not from approved vendors, how should we go about funding?
 - Chair Wyatt: We can fund for the total price that the SGA statutes allow and the Big Event can try to go through Full Press.
 - Senator Boisvert: Are the t-shirts only going to FSU students or all students at the event?
 - RSO representative: They would be going to all participants at the event
 - Chair Wyatt: SGA statues say that PAC funds can only go towards FSU students
 - President Diaz: Can you fundraise outside of PAC to contribute funds?
 - RSO representative: Since the organization is a RSO at FSU, they are the only ones funding.
 - Chair Wyatt: Is there a way that you can ensure whatever is funded only goes to FSU students?
 - RSO representative: Yes, we set up the groups based on schools so we could make everything separated by school.
 - Chair Wyatt: How many participants would you expect to be from FSU?
 - RSO representative: About 300.
 - **President Diaz motioned to enter roundtable discussion, seconded by Senator Boisvert**
- Roundtable:
 - President Diaz: What is the estimate of how much we are spending for 300 FSU students?
 - Chair Wyatt: If we take the amount that they budgeted for 500 people and then check what it would cost for 300 people, we would be spending \$1,020 for Panera and \$2,400 for t-shirts at \$8/shirt.
 - Chair Diaz: After looking at bylaws, it seems that as long as it is a majority of FSU students at the event, I believe we will be okay.
 - Point of Information from Chair Wyatt: Do the t-shirts include the SGA logo?

- RSO representative: Yes, they do include SGA acknowledgment.
- Point of Information from Chiar Wyatt: What is your advertisement strategy?
- RSO representative showed the instagram post. Post acknowledged SGA funding.

- **Notes of the Event/Item:**

- Opening
 - Chabad is planning on doing a mega event with JSU and Hillel. This will be the first event with all 3 Jewish Organizations for a very long time. They plan on hosting the event in Miller Hall that will be open to all students. There will be food and a speaker. They are requesting money for the food, speaker, and to rent out the space.
- Questions:
 - Chair Wyatt: Have you signed any contractual agreements?
 - RSO representative: They only signed the agreement with Miller's Hall.
 - Chair Wyatt: Are any of the other Jewish organizations helping fund the event?
 - RSO representative: Yes, they will be helping fund with whatever PAC cannot fund.

- Chair Wyatt: Can you push back the event?
- RSO representative: We want to do the event in January because it is Jewish Heritage Month but the other Jewish organizations are busy for many other weeks. We also have been posting the event already, so it might cause confusion if they pushed back the date.
- President Diaz: How much money are JSU and Hillel willing to contribute:
- RSO representative: A few hundred each. They were hoping to evenly split the cost, but all of the organizations cannot afford to pitch in thousands of dollars.
- President Diaz: Who is the speaker?
- RSO representative: Ishi Flesher. He is coming from Israel to talk about Jewish identity.
- Chair Wyatt: Are you aware that we cannot fund for plastic waterbottles? We will need to cut that from the request
- President Diaz: Do you think you can get this funding by Friday?
- RSO representative: I'm not sure
- Chair Wyatt explained that they timing of the request makes it really difficult to secure funding. While the RSO submitted more than 21 days out, the end of the semester, start of the new semester, and MLK day caused a mass delay in funding. It is not possible for SGA accounting to get funding to the RSO by Friday, especially for the contractual services.
- RSO Representative: Can we get reimbursed?
- Chair Wyatt: No, PAC cannot do reimbursements? Can you still put on the event with other funding? Or, can you push back the event? There is no way we can get funding for the contracts in this amount of time.
- RSO Presentative: Could we get the funding for just the food?
- Chair Wyatt: It would be cutting it very close but we can try.
- **Senator Bosivert motioned to enter roundtable discussion, Seconded by Daniel**
- Roundtable Discussion:
 - President Diaz: Unfortunately, I believe that accounting would advise us not to fund because of the date the event is planned for.
 - Chair Wyatt: I emailed accounting and they said we could not fund the contractual services. We can try to get the food funded.
 - President Diaz: If they cannot fund for the speaker, will the event happen at all?
 - Daniel: If they want to have the event without PAC funding for the speaker, should we still fund the food?
 - President Diaz: If they are okay with us funding for food and not the speaker, then we should fund the food.
 - Chair Wyatt: Without the water bottles, the food costs would be \$800.

- Point of Information from Chair Wyatt: Would you put the event on if you only got funding for food?
- RSO representative: We will have to talk to the other Jewish organizations. Since the speaker is over \$2,000, we would really need to look over everything. Can we get back to you with the decision?
- Chair Wyatt: Unfortunately, yes because the finance meeting is right after this meeting. Is there any way that you could push back the event?
- Point of Information from Senator Boisvert: Can we push through funding and then table the request if the RSO asks?
- President Diaz: Yes, we could amend tomorrow in the senate if the RSO wanted to.
- RSO representative: If the event was postponed, would PAC definitely get funded?
- Chair Wyatt: Yes, in the past many organizations have received funding for this event.
- **Motion to amend to only \$800 in the category of food. Seconded by Daniel.**

 - The Flute Association at FSU has a mission of promoting music and educational opportunities by hosting artists, fundraising

events, and social networking for FSU flute students, local high school students, and members of the surrounding community. They are requesting \$3,700 to host the world-renowned flutist Carol Wincenc. Their Artist-in-Resident Event will consist of a recital, lecture discussion, and two workshops held at the College of Music on Saturday, March 4, 2023. Carol Wincenc is the flute professor from Julliard School of Music. The Event is designed to allow interaction with professionals, gain feedback, and learn. Our theme this year is “Empowered Women”. They plan on advertising for the event on local TV stations, the Tallahassee Democrat, on social media, and by e-blasting to their email subscribers. They have fundraised by hosting receptions and have applied for and received corporate support and awards. They have not received any A&S funds this school year. They expect more than 85+ students and general public members. The money that they are requesting will go to contractual fees for Carol Wincenc. The total cost for the event is \$5,600.

- RSO representative: Yes we are.
- Chair Wyatt: But it is free for FSU students?
- RSO representative: Yes it is.
