○ **Notes of the Event/Item:**

- Notes: We ultimately decided not to fund this organization as they are just getting on their feet, so we decided the organizational fund would be a better fit for them.

- **Opening:** Hi, we are hosting the Auditor General from the State of Florida. Our organization helps students make connections with employers as well as their community. Since we are not a huge club, they are able to get that one-on-one connection. I was able to get an internship this way. We are just requesting some money for food and speakers. We want to use the speakers to create some background noise, so it is not dead silent during networking.

○ **Questioning:**

- **Parker Bevis:** How many members are in your organization?
 - **Representative:** It depends on what meeting you look at. We usually have about 20-25, but when we had the FBI come, we had over 100 attendees.
- **Chair Humberg:** Can you remind me how much you are requesting?
 - **Representative:** About \$160
- **Bevis:** Are two members of your organization financially certified?
 - **Representative:** Yes, three.
- **Huynh:** Have you done any outside fundraising?
 - **Representative:** We have tried to. Our organization died during COVID, so we are working with very limited funds from the previous organization. We are trying to get our finances and our fundraising reestablished.
- **Chair Humberg:** Will this event be open to everyone?
 - **Representative:** Yes

- **Opening:**
 - **Representative:** We are here to fund our Mid-Autumn Festival Banquet, and it is a collaboration between three organizations: VSA, KASA, and CASO. This banquet will showcase the traditions of the Mid-Autumn Festival. Our estimated attendance is 120 people based on the three organizations. Our expenses starting off with catering, the cheapest one is from Lemon Grass. This will include 4 entrees and 4 sides calculated by attendance coming to \$1,672. We have two other quotes, but they are more expensive. For the location, we had three different options, but the Wesley Foundation is the least expensive and very accessible from campus. This will cost \$825. The other two options were the Pearl Dining Club and Champions Club West. For décor, we want to go with our cheapest option of \$25.99 for a package of thirty lanterns. The cheapest photo backdrop is \$9.99. Both of these decor items are from Amazon. Our request totals \$2,532.98.

- **Questioning:**
 - **Huynh:** Have you all done any fundraising for this event?
 - **Representative:** We did a social media fundraiser with a bingo card and starter pack. We also had an Ur Bowl Share-It-Night.
 - **Chair Humberg:** We already funded The Chinese Students and Scholars Association for their Mid-Autumn Festival. Do you think that people will want to go to this event after the other one was held?
 - **Representative:** This will be a separate event; we have curated a unique theme, waterlilies and a purple background, and this is a collaboration with three organizations.
 - **Chair Humberg:** Did you all get any RSVPs?
 - **Representative:** We usually send those out when it gets closer, but as of right now, we have an estimated attendance of 120 and in the past, we have had 180 attendees. I've personally never heard of the Chinese Scholars, so I know they are not affiliated with CASA specifically.
 - **Chair Humberg:** Are you all okay if we fund you all for your cheapest options?
 - **Representative:** Yes
 - **Chair Humberg:** Would you be able to host this event if we funded you less?
 - **Representative:** It honestly depends on how much less. Our fundraisers made a few hundred dollars, so we would be able to cover that.
 - **Parker Bevis:** Is this event open to all FSU students?
 - **Representative:** Yes

Huynh moves to enter roundtable. Bevis seconds.

Roundtable Discussion:

Chair Humberg: I'm inclined to fund them as they are the only people this week.

Bevis: I'm willing to do it too.

Staveski: It is a collaboration between three organization, and they have done fundraising, and we have funded people who have not had these efforts. The only cut I could see us doing would be a few hundred, but I do not event think it's worth it.

Huynh: I have been to all of the AASU banquets, and they always have a sizable amount of people. They usually end up having more attendees than expected and everyone ends up with a little on their plate.
