## - Opening:

- Hi! I am the Treasurer for the Classical Guitar Society here at FSU where we seek to further the knowledge, understanding, and appreciation of the guitar. Each year we host the Florida Guitar Festival where we bring in artists from around the world to come perform and give masterclasses to FSU students, with this year's festival being especially important to us as our guitar professor who had been teaching at FSU for 50 years, just passed this summer. He has given us so much in the past. He has left behind a legacy in the classical guitar realm. This festival is in honor of him. We are bringing in Thomas Viloteau, a professor from John's Hopkins University, he originally asked for $\$ 1800$, but we need $\$ 2415$ to allocate for the hotel costs and flights.
- Questioning:
- Staveski: Can we fund for airfare and travel?
- Humberg: Yes, as that is included in the original quote so it's almost part of the performance, and he is not an FSU student.
- Huynh: How is the turnout usually?
- Representative: We usually have 200-300 people.
- Staveski: I see on your Instagram that you are already advertising the event, so if we do not fund you, will you still have the event?
- Representative: I am not entirely sure we may ask the College of Music if they could help fund.
- Humberg: Have you done any fundraising?
- Representative: We are having a concert fundraiser this Thursday, but it has been hard for us to fundraise as we have been coping with the loss of our professor.
- Staveski: If we were not able to fund you fully, would the event still happen?
- Representative: We would probably have to cancel the artist, cutting off a good portion of the event.
- Humberg: How much of this event do you all anticipate paying for?
- Representative: I'm not sure.
- Humberg: What is the fundraiser going to go towards?
- Representative: The festival
- Staveski: How much are you anticipating raising?
- Representative: I do not handle that, so I am not sure.
- Humberg: How did you arrive at the expected attendance?
- Representative: That number comes from FSU students as well as students flying in.
- Humberg: So, is there a fee to attend the event?
- Representative: It is free.
- Huynh: Would you all be open to charging for non-FSU students to lower the cost?

- Opening:
- We are a society that is here to support and encourage black women in medicine. We have a lot of different events where we talk about different health fields. We cater to anyone interested in health. We are asking to fund our end of year celebration. It is open to everyone. We are looking to recognize our members and hopefully attract prospective members. We will also be teaching a little about black history and black women's progression, specifically in medicine. We are asking for funding for the space, which is off campus, and for dinner. We are planning to advertise this through social media at least a month prior to the event. We are very active at Market Wednesday, and we are planning to pass out flyers there. The food will serve as an incentive for attendance. The first quote is a $\$ 1000$ for the venue; our chosen venue is the Four Points Sheraton. The other venues we looked at were more expensive, so this was the cheapest one. For the food portion, we are doing Olive Garden where we can get the most food for our money compared to our other options: Carrabba's and BJs.
- Questioning:
- Bevis: How many people are you expecting?
- Representative: We want to invite our club and open it up to the community. We are aiming to 60 of our members as well as encourage those not in the club to attend. We want a large variety of people to come to this event and have it be a big celebration.
- Staveski: Point, maybe to you Stella, can we fund off-campus events?
- Humberg: I did not see anything preventing us in the PAC guidelines, but a second set of eyes may be good.
- Staveski: If you could not have the event off-campus, would you be willing to move it on-campus like to the Union ballrooms.
- Representative: Yes, if it becomes an issue.
- Bevis: I found in statutes that we can fund it with a majority vote.
- Chair Humberg: Have you ever held this event before?
- Representative: We have but never to this scale.
- Chair Humberg: What do you think the attendance will be?
- Representative: We are expecting about 50 of our members and 20 from outside our organization.
- Chair Humberg: Have you all done any fundraising?
- Representative: Yes, we have sold lemonade and did a dollar sheet on social media.
- Chair Humberg: About how much would you say that is?
- Representative: So far this year, around $\$ 500$ or a $\$ 1000$ with dues.
- Humberg: What do you plan to use that money on?
- Representative: We've used a good portion of it on tshirts, and we buy a lot of snacks like pizza and candy for meetings. This year we started doing goody bags for our members which has been a big cost. This would be our most expensive event, and that is why we are asking for the funds.
- Staveski: How much is in your account right now?
- Representative: $\$ 4,000$, but $\$ 1,000$ will be going to $t$-shirts.
- Chair Humberg: So, after shirts, you would still have $\$ 3000$ ?
- Representative: Yes, and we also have another 1,000 in our Cashapp.

## - Roundtable Discussion:

- Chair Humberg: They have $\$ 4,000$, and right now, our total for the CR if we fully fund this is $\$ 5800$.
- Bevis: I was thinking we could cut the venue cost; they could theoretically have the event on campus.
- Chair Humberg: If you want to have a big networking event, I think people will be more likely to go on campus. Also, we are not the last stop; they can go to Finance and Senate. We have about $\$ 34,000$ left for this semester, so we do have the money.
- Bevis: I am willing to fund them for food, but I do not feel strongly about it.
- Huynh: It is hard to let go of the fact that they have $\$ 3,000$ not going towards anything when we have RSOs that come to us with just a few hundred dollars.
- Staveski: What is the CR without us finding them anything?
- Chair Humberg: $\$ 4,030$.
- Huynh: My reasoning for not wanting to fund them does not really have much to do with the CR itself, but more so about the fact that they could put the event on without our help.
- Humberg: Do you all want to call them in and ask?
- Bevis: Let's do it.
- Humberg: Realistically, without our help, would this event still happen?
- Representative: Probably not to the same scale as we want to. We have to give 15 percent of our dues to nationals. So, we could, but not to our desired scale.
- Humberg: So how much after the t-shirts and money to nationals, how much will you have?
- Representative: Probably around $\$ 3000$, but we have some other events coming up, and we do not want to drain our bank account for next semester, so the event would have to be much smaller.
- Bevis: At most, I am willing to fund them for half of the food.
- Huynh: I am not convinced either.
- Staveski: I want them to be able to hold their event to their desired scale, but I feel like from what they are telling us about their finances they could if they have the event on campus.
- Humberg: I'm looking right now to see if there is a good place on campus, they could hold the event for free. Apparently, the CDU space is free.
- Staveski: So, they are asking for 4 trays for how many people?
- Huynh: It says 70 plus, but the trays feed 8-14 people, so they are already asking for under with food. This would feed between 32 and 56 people. I do not know if they are just undershooting it or if that is the real, expected number.
- Huynh: At most, I would be willing to fund them for half the food.
- Bevis: I would be willing to give them half.
- Staveski: So, CDU is free. They have a viable place on campus to hold the event, and we are funding them for half the food since they have the money in their account.
- Huynh: I think that's fair.
