● **FSU Anthropology Society:**

○ **Preliminary Questions:**

- Asking for: 70-75 T-shirts
- Date Request Submitted: October 25th
- Date of Event: N/A

○ **Notes of the Event/Item:**

- Senator Gonzalez inquired about the RSO's intention with the shirts and addressed that the RSO cannot sell the shirts if they are to receive SGA funding.
- Senator Gonzalez inquired about the cost per shirt and mentioned that the quote the RSO brought was over the limit, the RSO was notified that they would have to cover the additional costs of the shirts.
- Senator Tackett inquired about the design of the shirt as well as the sizes planning to be purchased by the RSO.

- Due to concerns with quantity, color and size the committee and the RSO decided it would be best to table the organizations and have them return next week having addressed the committees' concerns.
