● **Flute Association at FSU:**

○ **Preliminary Questions:**

- Asking for: \$2,000 for two guest performers/lecturers.
- Date Request Submitted: November 12th
- Date of Event: January 7th-8th
- Number of Active Members: 50
- Number expected to come: 100
- Fundraised: \$400

○ **Notes of the Event/Item:**

- The RSO is requesting \$2,000 to cover 51% of the costs associated with their January 7th-8th event which will be open and advertised to the student body virtually through social media posts.
- This event will have Jill Felber and Dianne Frazer host free technical workshops and masterclasses for students over the two days, and they will also conduct a recital.
- The organization is working with a variety of organizations including the Saxophone Studio at FSU, Trombone Studio at FSU, Piano Accompanying Studio, FSU Women in Business, Music Teachers National Association at FSU, National Association for Music Education

Collegiate of FSU, The Women's Network, and Sisters2Service FSU to fundraise for this event.

- Member Rowan inquired about whether the performance can be streamed virtually to increase accessibility to the public. The organization responded by saying they can ask, but some artists aren't comfortable with having their work displayed like that in case they experiment with new material.
- Chair Roy asked if this was their first in-person event since Covid-19 moved many organizations to online events. The organization confirmed that this will be their first in-person event as a club since then.
- Member Rowan spoke highly of the organization because it was highly prepared with information on how it is fundraising, the flyers are already made, and they're even willing to ask about having the performance viewable for online participants.
- Member Devulapalli spoke highly of the organization because it had a really great PowerPoint and seemed beneficial to the student body.
- Member Simonson agreed with the previous two members and elaborated on how they were putting the performers to great use by having them do a performance and teach classes.
- Motion to fund the RSO \$2,000 in the Category of Contractual Services by Member Rowan, seconded by Member Devulapalli.
