- The treasurer for Audio Production club came two weeks ago for funding for tshirts. Their main issue was coming in over budget for each individual shirt at \$12, they are now coming in at around \$8 per shirt.
- Questions:
 - The picture you uploaded doesnt have a price?
 - Chair Wyatt: The invoice is separate should I drop it in the chat?
 - RSO Representative: Yes
 - Is there an email I can send it to or share screens?
 - \circ Yes, send the quote to the email.
 - Chair Wyatt: Only sizes small through large?
 - RSO Representative: Yes, thats all our members needed
 - Chair Wyatt: How are you passing the shirts out?
 - RSO Representative: Tabling on landis and potentially market wednesday.
 - Mausam: you said it suited the needs of members, are these shirts not for general student body?
 - RSO Representative: We prioritized saving money, we haven't encountered anyone with additional sizes interested in our club. It didn't make sense when we were drafting up our quote.
 - Chair Wyatt: Here, I will pull up the recommended breakdown for student sizes. Here is the financial manual. Typical breakdown requires 24% small,, 32% medium, 32% large, 10% X Large, 2% XXL, you guys should be providing shirts bigger and you should be providing two additional quotes in addition to full press. Even if those quotes do not fall in the pricing guideline, it is helpful for comparison. If you guys want to submit an additional request with the correct breakdown and additional quotes that would be best.
 - RSO Representative: Okay will do.
 - Daniel Ellison motioned to enter roundtable discussion, second by Julio Cesar Borges.

These tshirts are for our members to feel more included. There are 25 shirts for each size that we have here.

 - RSO Representative: It should be 25 in total on fullpress.
 - Chair Wyatt: In your other quote was it also 25?
 - RSO Representative: The other quote was for more than 25, we have 25 for each size.

 - RSO Representative:25 is the total amount we want to buy.

- Daniel: Are you aware that we cannot fund more than \$10 for small-xl and \$12 for above?
 - RSO Representative: No I was not aware of that.
- Mausam Jariwala: Are the shirts only for members?
 - RSO Representative: Yes
- Chair Wyatt: Would it be available for anyone not a member?
 O RSO Representative: No, it only goes to those who pay dues.

 - Julio Cesar Borges: unit price for the shirts is almost double what we are allowed to fund. Are we allowed to partial fund?
 - Chair Wyatt: Yes we can fund up to the amount we are allowed to. We are not allowed to fund things only going to club members.
 - Julio Cesar Borges: Thats another thing, I don't think we can.
 - Mausam Jariwala: Also the full press quote isn't correct because we don't know what sizes they're getting. Because it's only going to members I dont think we can fund them.
 - Daniel Ellison: can we fund the nametags only going to members?
 - Chair Wyatt: I think maybe?
 - Vice Chair Boisvert: maybe?
 - Julio Cesar Borges: I pulled up an example, because it is limited to only members it becomes likely to get vetoed.
 - Chair Wyatt: As you can see the statutes are very strict. Everything you have requested is only going to club members which we aren't allowed to fund. It must be available for the student body as well. All that info can be found in the statutes and the financial manual. Nametags is also something we cannot fund because it is only available to executive board members.

We need funding to bring him back, he is an award winning guitarist from Columbia. He is very well known, bringing him will attract a ton of attention.
 - Questions:
 - Chair Wyatt:Do you have an actual confirmation of how much he costs?
 - RSO Representative: Did you not get one when we submitted?
 - \circ Chair Wyatt: I only have the google doc with the overview.
 - RSO Representative: I can find it but it might take time, I can get that to you as soon as possible.
 - Julio Cesar Borges: When is the date you want the artist to perform?
 - Daniel Ellison: Was it march 25?
 - RSO Representative: Yes, I believe so.
 - Mausam Jariwala: You said you couldn't bring him to the last event, did you know he couldn't come before or after senate approved funding?
 - RSO Representative: He was a separate thing, he wasn't one funded by senate. We would like to bring him back.

- Daniel Ellison: What is the goal of this event?
 - RSO Representative: It's going to be held at the college of music. The artist will offer a masterclass and performance open to the public. Anyone can come see. He will be sharing information on classical guitar as well as a public concert.

 - Camp Kesem is a non-profit orginization to fund a camp experience for kids with cancer. We are planning for a 5k on March 4th 9am-11am on campus. We have several item request breakdowns from Costco, Publix, and Walmart. We are asking for funding for snacks (goldfish, bananas, etc) and drinks. Of the quotes, Walmart is the cheapest option. We are also hoping to receive funding for 60 t-shirts. We will be posting promotional info on social media to advertise the event.
 - Questions:
 - Mausam Jariwala: Do you have a picture of the shirt design?
 RSO Representative: Yes, this is it on the screen.
 - Chair Wyatt: Is the event free for FSU Student?
 - RSO Representative: No, we will be charging \$15 per ticket and \$20 per shirt
 - Chair Wyatt: Accoridng to FSU Statutes, PAC funding cannot be provided to events that charge an entrance fee for FSU Students. We can cover the shirts, but we need to ensure the event is free for all fsu students, is that something that can work?
 - RSO Representative: Can we do free attendance and shirts and raise money separately?

- RSO Representative: We can do that, 100%
- Daniel Ellison: Which is your desired quote for the shirts?
 - RSO Representative: Full press
 - Chair Wyatt: We can only fund up to \$12 for 2XL, so that extra 30 cents would come out of pocket.
 - RSO Representative: That's fine.
- Daniel Ellison: What was your desired vendor for the food?
 - RSO Representative: Costco.
 - Chair Wyatt: We would have to amend the amount for T-shirts, we wouldn't have to amend to fund the Publix order.
- Mausam Jariwala: The amount of shirts is different on the different quotes, would it be okay if we could only fund for 50 shirts instead of 60?
 - RSO Representative: Yes.

 - Opening:
 - Relay for Life is a fundraiser that raises money for cancer research and current cancer patients. We aim to bing the community together and cause lasting change. At FSU the student body benefits by receiving both entertainment and fundraising experience. Our event is free for anyone. Our event centers around the stage for programming that requires audio and video equipment. Without a sound system and video screens we would not be able to host our event. We advertise through word of mouth, instagram, tabling, etc. to ensure maximum outreach. We are rebuilding this year in response to covid, but we have already received great involvement. Other philanthropy events offer tshirts as incentives and we would like to do the same. Our goal is to honor and remember loved ones who ahve suffered from cancer and to provide education.
 - Questions:
 - Daniel Ellison: How many fsu students do you expect?
 - RSO Representative: In the past we have seen 700, but this year we expect 800 or more because our event in inside. Currently we have +500 people registered.
 - Chair Wyatt: You are just asking for audio/visual in the line item correct? Does FSU not have that equipment available?
 - RSO Representative: No, they only have a stage so far.

- Daniel Ellison: Where was this event held last time?
 - RSO Representative: At the old IM Fields
- Mausam Jariwala: How many people can the ballrooms hold?
 - We don't know, but we can hold up to 60 tables which should hold all our teams.
- Julio Cesar Borges: Have you done any fundraising to cover the event?
 - RSO Representative: No, 100% of our fundraising goes to the American Cancer Society. No budget for production costs.
- Chair Wyatt: Why did you decide to go with the second quote?
 - RSO Representative: We've always used that company for the event and we've heard it is what they used in the ballrooms. We would be more than happy to use the other quote. The American vendor gives us 25% off because of our charity status. They have always been our top choice and know how our event runs.
- Chair Wyatt: Does the tshirt have the SGA logo on it?
 o RSO Representative: Yes
- Daniel Ellison: What was the though process for choosing full press?
 - RSO Representative: Same as before, our advisor said to use full press as the preferred vendor. We are happy to use any of the quotes.
- Julio Cesar Borges: You are expecting at least 700 people at the event? Have you offered t shirts in the past?
 - RSO Representative: Yes to the first question. No we have not. We used to have to request more for the IM Fields but this year the cost is lower for the ballrooms and stage. Last year there were weather difficulties so this is our rebuilding year. We are #9 in the country in terms of success for our organization.
- Julio Cesar Borges motioned to enter roundtable discussion, seconded by Mausam Jariwala.
- Roundtable:
 - Mausam Jariwala: Since they've already worked with American we can keep that but use the other tshirt quote because it's cheaper.
 Julio Cesar Borges: I agree.
 - Daniel Ellison: Is there a difference in quality for vendors?
 - Chair Wyatt: It sounds like because the union typically uses the American company, I would be comfortable funding it.
 - Chair Wyatt: The total for American is \$5630, for tformation it is \$2542.50.
