PAC Budget: 29,930

Engineers without border

- National non profit organization
- School house in Guatemala
- Requesting t-shirts for the club
- Grown from 5 to 30 people
- Want students from all majors
- Wants 550 shirts
- Ran out of less than 200 shirts at the involvement fair
- Community outreach
- 25 dollar dues for the semester
- Bands without border is there benefit concert fundraiser; 5 dollar entrance fee
- Raised 1000 at the concert
- Has to provide 95 percent of the project
- A year and a half with the village
- Flyers on campus and tabling

Decision of PAC: \$1,728 funding for 6 dollars each for 288 shirts

African Student Association

- FAMU and FSU work together a lot
- 60 people are FSU students
- At the gbms they will be distributing
- Use social media and market Wednesday and emails to promote
- Dues are 10 dollars a semester
- We have fundraiser with African meals and sell them
- 500 dollars were fundraised last year

Decision of PAC: \$600 funding 100 shirts at 6 each. They can fundraise the rest. Funding 100 shirts to give out to the student body.

- Starting a t-shirt fundraiser
- Trying share it nights
- This activity will be open to the members
- Average person will use 5-7 plates
- Probably 10-15 people
