### Muslim Student Association

- Money is requested for the end of the year banquet on April 17th
- This is the second time requesting money this year, the first requested was for holiday banquet \$60
- They are requesting \$850 for food and supplies of the event
- The supplies include plates napkins ect. from Publix
- The food will be from the Persis restaurant and is \$6.10 per person
- Of the estimated 115 people roughly 80% will be students the rest from the community
- Most of the fundraising came from the muslim community along with co hosting several events
- MSA does not require dues however there is a voluntary donation
- Advertisement is through their email list and social media
- For this event they will be sending out an RSVP link
- Still have \$223.47 in their SGA account from their organizational funds
- Decision: \$487
- Reason: fully funding expenses, funding 80% of the costs for the students attending minus the money already in their SGA account

### Belly Dancers

- Requesting \$500 for a promotional video
- The video will display the organization and be posted on social media
- Classes are free to the student body
- Goal is to promote their mission and display their organization to the student body
- Facebook account has roughly 2000 followers
- Video will also be displayed at their showcase on April 16th
- 9 active performance members 50 students that attend the classes
- 2 share it nights each roughly revenue \$100
- No dues
- Received \$200 in organizational funds
- Videographer has done videos for several clubs and different businesses in town
- They currently have \$500 in account which is going toward their brunch at 1851
- Decision: Tabled until next meeting

- Reason: to get more quotes for the video and look into resources for the video services available on campus.

## Gospel Choir

- Money to pay for missions for spring concert on 4/20 which is free to all students
- The musicians will amplify sound along with their members
- Provide an energetic voice to the concert
- Total cost for the musicians is \$400
- Requested \$250
- Expected attendance is 400 with members of community and students filling the Opperman Hall
- Each member pays \$50 per year
- 10 due paying members
- Costs for the semester was for last semesters concert, they did not come to PAC for that concert
- They would be able to contribute \$150
- Currently have \$200 in accounts, keeping \$50 in the account for a end of the year social
- Decision of PAC: \$250
- Reason of PAC: Fully fund due to the benefit to the student body and the organizations willingness to pay for a large portion.

## The Literary Society

- Seeking funding for their final meeting on April 25th in order to expand and attract more students on campus
- No dues
- For non-fsu students 125% of the per person cost of the food will be charged
- Planning on 50 people attending
- currently 15 people are attending meetings
- the funds will go towards food for the meeting
- Did not get organizational fund
- Currently have zero funds
- This is their first semester as an RSO
- Decision of PAC :\$42
- Reason: 7 pizzas from seminole pies at \$6 a large one topping pizza
