 - Sudden cardiac arrest is the leading cause of death in the young. Through Who We Play For, we will be providing 350 free EKG screenings for students during the FSU Women's Health Day Event. Average EKG costs are as high as \$150, and Who We Play For provides them for as little as \$20. Through screenings, the EKGs will be read by certified cardiologists who are a part of the Who We Play For team. This benefits the student body as we will

be promoting awareness of sudden cardiac arrest as well as screening students. Because the event will be taking place outside, the purpose of the tents is to provide coverage for students at the EKG machines. The screenings will be conducted under the event in a private setting that is shielded by dividers.
