A transfer of \$3,420 from Senate Projects to Facilities to purchase and install one water station with bottle filler in the Bellamy Building on FSU's Campus. **(Referred to Student Life and Budget. Passed Student Life 04.19. Pending in Budget.)**
- Bill 52 Sponsored by Senators Dale and Faletti (P)
This eliminates the position of secretary from being a major office. **(Referred to Internal Affairs and Judiciary. Amended and Passed in Internal Affairs 04.18. Pending in Judiciary.)**
- Bill 53 Sponsored by Senators DuChêne (P)
Eliminating the statutorily mandated Senate mentor program. **(Referred to Judiciary and Rules. Pending in Judiciary and Rules.)**
- Bill 54 Sponsored by Senator DuChêne (P)
To add the option of an abbreviated version of the Indigenous Land Acknowledgment Statement, to be used where deemed appropriate in lieu of the longer statement. **(Referred to Student Life and Judiciary. Passed Student Life 04.19. Pending in Judiciary.)**
- Bill 56 Sponsored by Senator Humberg (P)

This bill would allow students enrolled in the Panama City campus the ability to vote for Student Body Treasurer, and also amends the Panama City statutes to modernize the language surrounding their voting procedures.

Amending the appointment procedures for at-large members of the Golden Torch Lecture Series committee, and for other purposes.
