Questions:

- What are the funds for?
 - NEW would like to provide medical students nutritional education by hosting a "Build your own overnight oatmeal station" at the FSU courtyard.COM students, staff, and faculty can come to a table where NEW members will help them prepare their own overnight oatmeal mason jar to take home. The tables will include mason jars which they can take home, and food products to create the overnight oats such as oatmeal, milk products, fruits, sweeteners, and syrups. To build the mason jar we will charge \$6 per jar and use the money to fundraise for future events. The table will be supervised by two new members, and only one person can create their overnight oatmeal jar at a time, to maintain social distancing.
- Note: This event is part of a planned Nutrition Exercise and Wellness week in mid to late April 2021
- Note: Because of Covid-19 guidelines food that is not prepackaged cannot be distributed.
- Note: MSC funds cannot be used to fundraise for RSOs.
