Roundtable Reports

- Jack Hitchcock - Administrative Director
- Juan Bustamante - Director of Sustainability
 - Met with Senate President Abril Hunter and the Director of Student Sustainability and realigned priorities for Student Sustainability. Abril is going to form an Ad Hoc for Sustainability that both Abril and Juan will be chairing. They will be sponsoring legislation with about \$500 total for U-Locks for bikes to keep bikes safe. They will

also be inviting people to a bike safety class and teach people how to be safe and to promote more safe bike riding.

- They will also be exploring a way to expand the garden to give out food and/or provide the food to the Food Pantry. SGA originally funded the food garden and encouraged us to expand the garden by sponsoring the space. SGA will need to sponsor working hours to build these plots. Sustainable Campus is requesting pavers and soil for the project. This will be a big expansion for Presidential Scholars for them to help with the project.
- In an effort to explore an on-campus Market, we have decided it might not be attainable to have. We think it would be better to have an online system for having a drop/off and pick up place for people to be able to buy produce online and get it on-campus. There is a complicated process to this so it is hard to think about but getting a well-rounded online system would be best for students. A lot of these vendors accept EBT/SNAP benefits.
- There will be a food expo on September 15th in the Union Ballroom and will provide SGA with a table.
- Kaitlynn Adams - Director of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
 - She met with Brianne Basdeo about stuff that she would still like to accomplish.
 - Cultural Learning project, she had a meeting with the HLSU staff and was recommended to just get lunch with the agencies to make them feel like you don't always have to be professional. So, when stuff goes wrong in the community, that is not the only time that we are reaching out. This ensures that our outreach is not performative but deeply rooted in the community. She has set up a meeting with the JSU staff and will be calling BSU and VSU to set up a meeting soon.
 - The Woman's Honorary is going to be in tuned with inclusive language and will work for people who do not identify as women too.
- Liz Iaconis - Director of Academic Engagement
 - Dr. Barry suggested that we work with the registrar for future projects. Liz cannot find anything online about the registrar's office. She also reached out to Dr. Chicken, the Chair of the Faculty Senate, to establish a relationship for a syllabus registry. This will also be extended into audit work for people who have had negative experiences with Professor's. Liz also has plans to get tutoring resources put into everyone's syllabi.
- Mike Delcin - Director of Communications
 - He is working on posts for the highlighting series that Cabinet will be doing.
 - Working on the yard signs for Garnet and Gold Votes and the yard signs.
