- Land Acknowledgement:
 - The Student Government of Florida State University acknowledges that it is located on land that is the ancestral and traditional territory of the Apalachee Nation, the Miccosukee Tribe of Florida, the Muscogee Creek Nation, and the Seminole Tribe of Florida. Legislative Roundtable

- Bowling: We funded SAP at a higher rate because they serve more students overall.
 Case Competition would serve only 4 students per conference compared to WAP's over 100 students.
- Wildmann: Total participants for WAP is 156. They initially requested 22,500, which is more than the total amount. We added proviso language that no funding should be used for faculty. Case competition must participate in the Washington Tacoma conference and Stetson to maximize participants

- Bettley: We did not fund case competition for events because the cost is 1 thousand per student.

 - o Bowling: RSO emails change frequently but this is a good idea
