AMS is a conference that meteorology students attend that will be in Denver Colorado from 1/7-1/12, allowing students to market while presenting research gathered at FSU. This event allows students to grow their skills while growing a network of other researchers in the world.

 - Sena: Do you have an exact amount for attendees?
 - Szot: The exact amount will be \$3,755
 - Widmann: What was the process for advertisement, and how were members selected to attend?
 - Szot: This was open to all FSU students and we advertised in our General Body Meetings and we also had a conference information meeting, we also advertised the informational meeting on social media. No one was excluded from attending.
 - Widmann: To Clarify, there are 3 members attending one conference costing \$85 total and all other members are attending the conference and the annual meeting will pay \$250 total, \$165 for the meeting and \$85 for the student portion.
 - Szot: That is correct
 - Widmann: How are members affording lodging, and is that coming out of pocket?
 - Szot: Members are lodging together and splitting the price. All travel expenses and lodging are coming out of pocket. We are only requesting money for the registration fee.
 - Widmann: Do you have a total that everyone will be paying per person?
 - Szot: I would estimate that it is \$1000 per person so it is vital that
 we get the registration fee that will cover 25% of the costs for all
 members.
 - Widmann: Do all students have to pay a \$25 membership fee to attend the conference on top of the \$60 to attend.
 - Szot: The additional \$25 is for the National Chapter directly, but it is also a part of the registration fee because you have to register as a national member
