**WHEREAS:** There were 22,485 parking permits issued in 2016

**WHEREAS:** There are 11,330 parking spaces available to students on campus

**WHEREAS:** Only 5,626 of these spaces are available to students within FSU garages

**WHEREAS:** According to a recent article in the Tallahassee Democrat "Rising enrollment coupled with the recent opening of new residence halls, expanding dining services and the construction of academic-research buildings, have crimped parking on the [FSU] campus."

**WHEREAS:** The Florida State University 69<sup>th</sup> Student Senate serves in the best interest of the student body

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SIXTY NINTH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:** The Florida State University Student Senate supports the implementation of a revised parking forgiveness program

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:** The Florida State University Student Senate recommends this program allow students to waive the fee on their first parking citation that violates fine code 01, and replace it with the completion of 5 community service hours.
